QUOTATION CONDITIONS/INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

These conditions are an integral part of this quotation and the vendor must comply with them.

1. Quote Submittals

Vendor must Quote on the included form and as requested.

Vendor should make copy of Quote for his or her file.

The vendor's name and address must appear on the outside of the envelope. If the quote was downloaded from the internet or sent electronically, then the vendor must clearly write the quote name (**Used 2009 E450 Goshen Coach GC-II QUOTE**) and VIN number on the outside of the envelope along with the vendor's business name.

If submitted by email, the heading shall contain: **Used 2009 E450 Goshen Coach GC-II QUOTE and the name of your company.** Do not use this terminology for information only as the email will not be opened until the closing of bids.

Similarly, submissions by fax shall have a cover paged titled: **Used 2009 E450 Goshen Coach GC-II QUOTE and the name of your company.** Such faxes will not be read until after the closing of the bidding process.

2. Once all quotes have been opened and amounts have been tabulated the highest bidder will be contacted for acceptance or rejection of the purchase. Should the highest bidder reject the purchase of the vehicle the next highest bidder will be contacted for acceptance. Bidders will have to respond with acceptance or rejection no later than two business days from notification.

3. Specification Inquiries

4. Bidder/Offer or Representation

Each bidder/offeror must sign the quote with his/her usual signature and shall give his/her full business address on the form provided in this quote. Quotes by partnership shall be signed with the partnership name by one of the members or by an authorized representative. Quotes by corporations shall be signed with the name of the corporation followed by the signature and designation of the president, secretary or other person authorized to bind it in the matter.

5. Rejection of Quote

Quotes may be considered irregular and may be rejected if they show omissions, alterations of form, additions not called for, conditions, limitations or other irregularities of any kind. The Hospital reserves the right to waive minor technicalities or irregularities of quote.

6. Award

The Hospital shall award to the overall highest responsible and responsive vendor complying with the provisions of the quote.

7. Errors/Omissions/Discrepancies

Any errors, omissions or discrepancies in the specifications discovered by a prospective contractor and/or service provider shall be brought to the attention of Jocelyn Bourgoïn as soon after discovery as possible. Further, the contractor and/or services provider shall not be allowed to take advantage of errors, omissions or discrepancies in the specifications.

No quote award will be made at the time of the opening.

8. Telegraphic/Electronic Quote Submittal

adequate time for delivery of their quote either by airfreight, postal service, or other means.

Comments: Vehicle was used 1-3 days per week between April 2009 and March 31st 2010 to ferry passengers from Manitowadge to Thunder Bay Ontario with same day return. Total kilometers per trip was about 900 kms. The vast majority of the kms on this vehicle are highway travel. Currently, the vehicle needs a new heater summer shut off valve under the floor to shut off the auxiliary heaters at the rear of the van. The existing valves could not be shut off due to corrosion when the warmer weather returned and were bypassed to maintain operations. The wheelchair lift is due for annual inspection. There is some surface rust evident in select locations. The small side window behind the driver has been replaced with a Plexiglas panel.

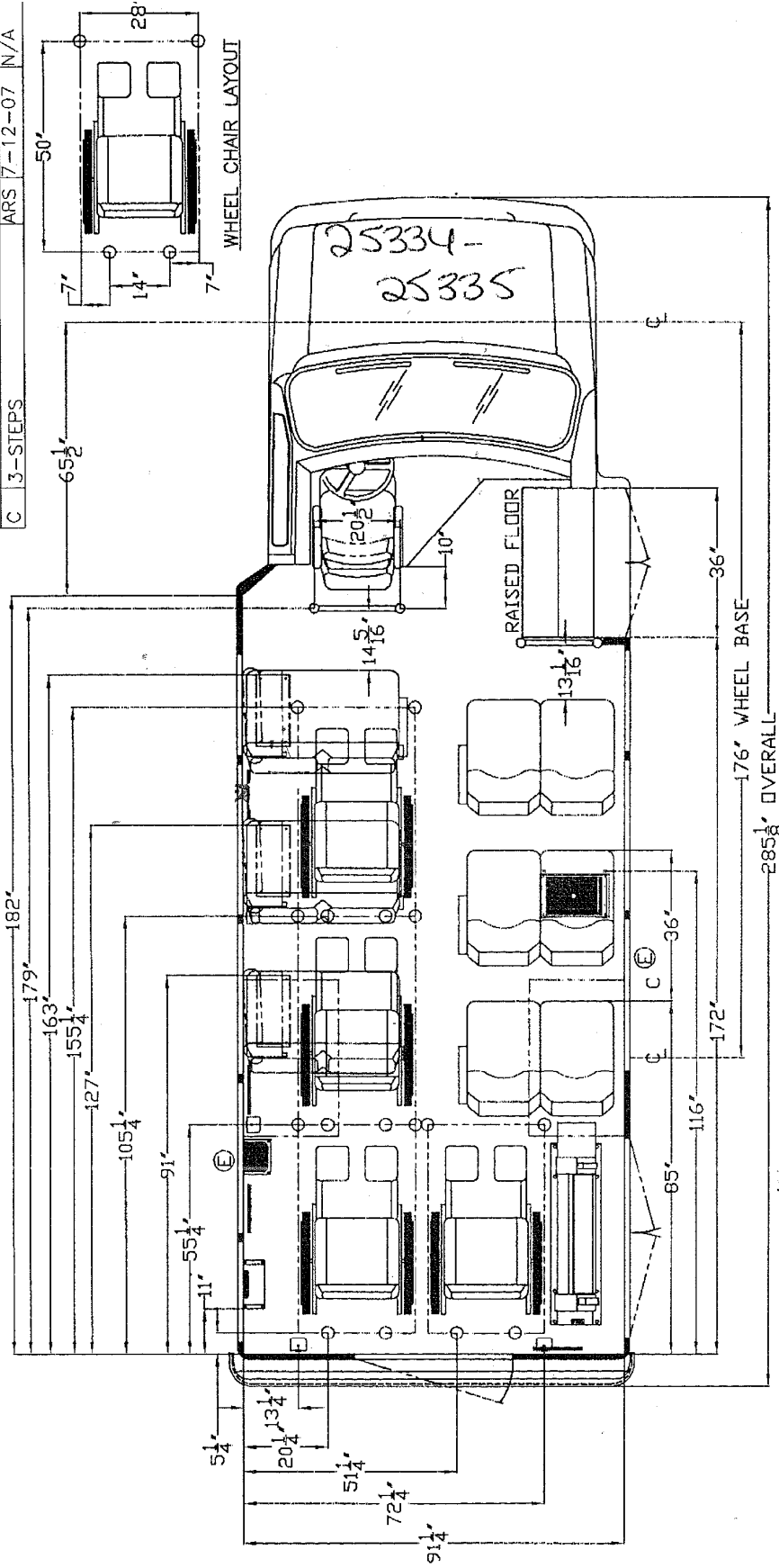
