- Related Degree or Diploma in health promotion i.e. public health, health sciences, kinesiology, social sciences, or other
- Strong skills in program planning, community engagement, communication, and evaluation
- Experience working in a Family Health Team, Community Health Centre, or primary care setting preferred
- Knowledge of chronic disease management, health promotion strategies, and population health approaches
- Familiarity with Ontario primary care programs and preventive care guidelines
- Training in motivational interviewing, health coaching, or self-management support is an asset
- Bilingualism is an asset.

- Computer and Keyboarding skills required
- Regular attendance at work is required

Responsibilities:

- Provide individual and group-based health education in collaboration with Interdisciplinary Team (e.g., diabetes, hypertension, COPD)
- Use motivational interviewing and behavior change techniques to support patient self-management and goal setting
- Plan, implement, and evaluate health promotion programs aligned with FHT priorities and community needs
- Support preventive care initiatives, including cancer screening, immunizations, and lifestyle risk assessments



- Identify and address social determinants of health by connecting patients to appropriate community and social services
- Lead the coordination and implementation of community health promotion programs, including educational workshops and outreach events focused on disease prevention, healthy lifestyles, and access to care
- Maintain accurate and timely documentation in the electronic medical record (EMR) in accordance with FHT standards
- Collect and analyze data to support quality improvement initiatives and reporting requirements
- Participate in team meetings, and organizational planning activities
- Contribute to the development of policies, protocols, and patient education resources
- Provide presentations and education sessions for the community, community partners and other organizations as needed, community initiatives, and organizing health fairs.
- Liaison with Santé Manitouwadge Health
- Workplace Wellness
- Ensure Compliance with PHIPA
