Practice Hours

• Average 3-4 days/week plus hospital work

Your experienced support team includes nursing, a social worker, a dietitian, a physiotherapist, diabetes educator, as well as supportive administration staff. The hospital provides diagnostic imaging (x-ray and ultrasound), and laboratory services.

Currently patients are seen from 0900hrs to 1200hrs and 1300hrs to 1530hrs with availability for fit in at the end of each clinic day. Appointments are 20-30 minutes in length. Admin time is incorporated into your schedule weekly. Nursing takes the lead on preventative screening so you may choose to focus your practice on other areas.

Patient Volume

The community has a population under 2000 residents, all of which access health care locally. The Hospital Emergency Room sees 5-6 visits per day, with most (>80%) of those visits at low or very low acuity. We are 54 kms from the main highway and see minimal major trauma.

Call Arrangements

Physicians share ER call responsibilities (no Obstetrics). The average call is two days on, two days off, and three days on (weekend) or vice versa. Access to specialist support is only a phone call away at the regional state-of-the-art tertiary centre, and the ED has telemedicine connection that provides real time videoconference contact with trauma and intensive care specialists 24-7. While on ER call, physicians cover a 10 bed in-patient unit and a 9 bed LTC unit within the same SMH building as the Clinic and FHT. Call is 1 and 3 (when fully staffed) and you would be able to sleep through most nights at home. While on call, you will be covering short urgent care clinics during the week.

Compensation Details

Very competitive remuneration is provided through RNGPA contract/salary for clinic and on call.
