

COVID-19 updates for visitors to Santé Manitouwadge Health

effective December 30, 2021

Longterm Care/ALC Residents and Acute care patients

- All residents/patients are able to have 2 designated essential caregivers visit at a time. (designated ahead of time and cannot be frequently changed)
 - Must be at least 16 years of age
 - Must be fully vaccinated and show proof
 - Must pass daily screening
 - Must provide proof of a negative antigen swab twice weekly. Antigen swabs for caregivers can be arranged Monday, Wednesday and Friday between 10am and 2 pm at SMH.
 - Masks are required at all times
- General visitors are paused at this time (including outdoor visits)
- All day absences for social purposes have been suspended
- Must sign in and sign out using the Visitor Log Book.

End of Life (Palliative) patients/residents

- General visitors will be allowed to visit patients/residents receiving end of life care
- 2 visitors at a time
- Anyone under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult (over 18 years of age)
- Must sign in and out using the Visitor Log book

General Reminders

- Medical masks must be worn at all times when coming to SMH
- You will be screened at either the main entrance or the Family Health Team entrance
- Get fully vaccinated!
- Wash hands frequently
- Limit contact with others, avoid crowds, large social gatherings and gatherings with unvaccinated people
- Physically distance when with unvaccinated people
- If you are not feeling well, stay home
- Follow all Public Health Guidance
